1. What five AI models find when they look the site up

On 29 September 2026 each model was asked two questions about super.tennis with live web search on: what the site is, and which of its pages it can find. The sources each one cited are split into pages of the site itself and pages elsewhere. A model that cites the site's own pages could reach and use them this time. One that answers from other sites only, or cites nothing, did not use the site in this run. This is one run: answers vary between runs, users and days.

3. What to fix, in order
